Periodic Table: click on any element in the Periodic Table will take you to the element's properties table. On the properties table page, click on the "See full article" to go to the complete article on the elements.



Geological Time Scale: click on any time period in the diagram will take you to the complete article on that time period.

Searching

Quick Search

A quick search can be conducted from the front page.

- Enter your search term (word or phrase)
- Then click **Search**
- **Results** list will be group into the category of Encyclopedia Articles, Research Updates, Biographies, Q&A, News, Multimedia as well as Dictionary.

Advanced Search

- *Search by Content Type*

1. Enter the search term(s);
2. Mark the boxes to the left that you want to find the search terms in; or
3. Select one or more content types/topic areas to search within; or
4. Click **Search** to see results.

- *Search by Topic*

1. Select a topic;
2. Click the subtopic that interests you;
3. View list of articles and research updates.

Select a Section to Begin

A. Biographies

- Provides information on Nobel Prize and fields medal winners in the field of science and technology.
- Users may search (i) A-Z Biographies (ii) Biographies by Subject.

B. News

- Provides "This Week's News"; "News Archive" and News by Subject".

C. Student Center

- **Q & A:** The editors periodically select questions of great general interest and post their answers in the Q & A section of this site.
- **Topical Study Guides:** A program of study with links to relevant articles.
- **AP (Advanced Placement) Study Guide:** provide a plan for a program of study and reference and include online quizzes and links into relevant AccessScience content.
- **Essay Topics:** Suggestions for research papers and essays. Also to help students learn about a specific subject. For each topics, the editors have provided a list of articles to start your research.
- **Bibliography:** The literature citations on the articles organized by topic.

D. Image Gallery

- Explore scientific phenomena through pictures.

E. Multimedia

- Explore scientific information through animation, image and video.

Explanation of the icons

AccessScience Topic pages are organized by the kind of content available on a given topic, which can include the following:

- E Encyclopedia article:** Articles from McGraw-Hill's Encyclopedia of Science & Technology.
- R Research Update:** New articles with the latest developments in science and technology from McGraw-Hill Yearbooks.
- B Biography:** Biographies from the Hutchinson Dictionary of Scientific Biography.
- N News:** Science News© articles on breaking news in science and technology.
- D Dictionary:** Definitions from the AccessScience online science dictionary.
- I Image Galleries:** Content taken from AccessScience Image Galleries containing pictures and explanation.
- M Multimedia:** Multimedia content (animations, news videos, and Images of the Week).

Printing
