

Global Reference on the Environment, Energy, and Natural Resources (GREENR)



GREENR offers reference content in the area of the environment, energy and natural resources. The database combines news, unique commentary, audio, video, primary source documents, and case studies into a web-like experience. It also offers interactive maps, opportunities for forums, customizable journals and news, and statistics of various areas such as energy systems, health care, food, climate change, population and economic development etc.



- You may limit results by entering
 - Document type;
 - Content type;
 - Publication subjects;
 - A date or range of dates for the publication;
 - Publication format and/or
 - Document number.
- Click on *Search* button.

Result

- A **Portal page** that matches the search criteria will be displayed.

- Search results will be categorized into *Academic Journals, Associations, Book Reviews, Case Studies, Get Involved, Images, Magazines, News, Podcasts, Presentations, Primary Sources, Research Centers and Special Libraries, Reference, Statistics, Videos, and Websites and Blogs.*

Browse Issues And Topics

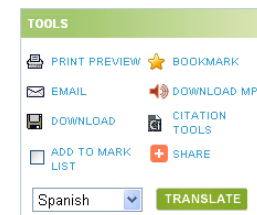
- Browse from the list of current issues by clicking a **pictured category**, such as:
 - Agriculture and Food Systems
 - Energy
 - Humans in the Natural World
 - Pollution
 - Science and Technology
 - Economics and Trade
 - Environment and Ecology
 - Law and Politics
 - Resource Management
 - Social Factors
- Click one of the **specific issues** displayed under a category image.

World Map

- By using an interactive map, **World Map**, select geography to search for information on specific country or region and its related environmental issues and headline news.

Tools

- Bookmark – You can have the bookmark URL for citation or email it to yourself or others.
- Citation Tools – You may have the citation formatted in MLA 6th or 7th edition, APA or Plain Text with Bibliographic Tags.
- Download – You may download the information in the format of HTML or Plain text with bibliographic tags.
- Share – You can share information with shortcut to Google, myAOL, Twitter, Facebook and more.
- Translate – You can translate the document in different languages such as French, Spanish, Japanese, German, Italian, Portuguese, Chinese(Simplified), Korean and English.



Searching

Basic Search

- Enter one or more words in the **Basic Search** box and then click *Search* button.

Advanced Search

- Click the **Advanced Search** link and enter term(s) and index type(s) in the search box.
- Select limitation to “peer-reviewed publications”, “documents with images”, or ”full-text documents”.

Search History

1. Click *Search History* button from the page banner, a history of the searches will be displayed. The most recent search displays at the top of the list, with a maximum of 50 previous search queries displayed.

Printing

1. Use the print function of browser to print.
2. Follow the standard procedures to pay for and collect the printouts.

Search Operator

*	Stands for any number of characters, including none. For example, pigment* matches <i>pigment</i> , <i>pigments</i> , <i>pigmentation</i> , etc.
?	Stands for exactly one character and is especially useful when you're uncertain of a spelling. For example, relev?nce matches <i>relevance</i> .
!	Stands for one or no characters and is especially useful when you want to match the singular and plural of a word. For example, colo!r matches both <i>color</i> (American) and <i>colour</i> (British).
Wn	W is a within operator. For example, the search expression shared w3 values matches any records in which the word <i>values</i> occurs three or fewer words after the word <i>shared</i> .
Nn	N is a near operator. For example, the search expression sun n5 moon matches any records in which the words <i>sun</i> and <i>moon</i> occur within five or fewer words of each other in either direction.
