Other Requirements

- Participants should be students (Primary 1 – Secondary 6) of local day schools.
- All entries should be nominated and submitted by schools.
- Each school can nominate up to 5 entries for each category.
- Except the Junior Primary Category, other categories **must quote the source of reading materials on the application form:**
 - Book – title, author(s), publisher and year of publication
 - Newspaper or periodical – title, page number and issuing date
 - Website – name of website, URL and date of browsing
 - Non-print materials – the source(s), year of publication, etc.
- Entries should use papers in accordance with the stipulated requirements, such as the indication of page number and word count:
 - Entries of the Junior Primary Category should be A4 size (210 mm x 297 mm), drew on a single-sided white cardboard paper.
 - Entries of other categories should be computer printed or clearly written in **black ballpoint pen** on 400-grid script paper for Chinese entries or A4 size paper (210 mm x 297 mm) for English entries.
 - Personal data of participant and name of school CANNOT be shown on the entry.**
- The entry should be original work by the participant. Plagiarized or published work (including Internet) or work already involved in other competitions will not be accepted.
- Entries submitted by post or by hand (applicable to all categories): Each entry should be submitted together with ONE completed application form to: Extension Activities Unit, Hong Kong Public Libraries, Room 901, 9/F Fa Yuen Street Municipal Services Building, 123A Fa Yuen Street, Mongkok, Kowloon **on or before 5 January 2022** via the participating school (Please mark "4·23 World Book Day Creative Competition in 2022" on the envelope). For entries sent by post, the postmark date will be regarded as the date of submission. Late submission and mail items with insufficient postage will not be accepted.

- Entries submitted by email (except the Junior Primary Category) Each entry should be submitted together with ONE copy of the completed application form to: aeo2@lcsd.gov.hk on or before 5 January 2022.
 - Please mark "4·23 World book Day Creative Competition in 2022" in the subject of the email. For entries sent by forwarded email, the forwarded email date will be regarded as the date of submission. Late submission will not be accepted.
 - Please indicate the number of entries of each category enclosed in the email.
 - The entry must be submitted in MS Word or in PDF format with A4 size.
 - Schools must send the application forms with student signatures and school chops by post or by hand after submitting entries by email.

- The application form can be photocopied for use.

- The adjudicators' decision is final and any appeals by participating schools or students will not be considered.

- All entries submitted will not be returned to schools and/or participants.

- Authors of the winning entries to the competition (who are copyright owners of the works) agree to grant the HKSAR Government the license to use the winning entries, including but not limited to reproduce, record, edit, publish for sale, donate, display, promote, perform, broadcast, as well as store them on the HKSAR Government managed systems for public to access through internet.
