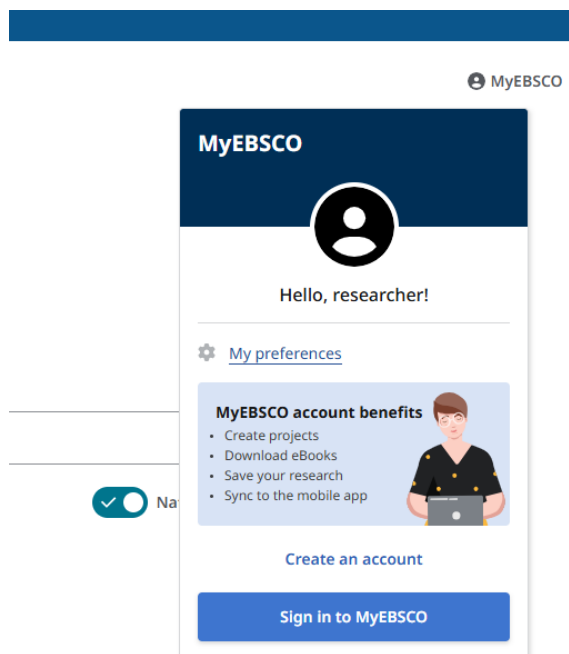


eBooks on EBSCOhost User Guide

Step 1: Create your personal account


Create a **MyEBSCO account** for first-time users or sign in to MyEBSCO by clicking on “MyEBSCO” button at top right corner.


Step 2: Searching for EBSCO e-Books

Perform a keyword search using the search box, or click “Advanced search”.

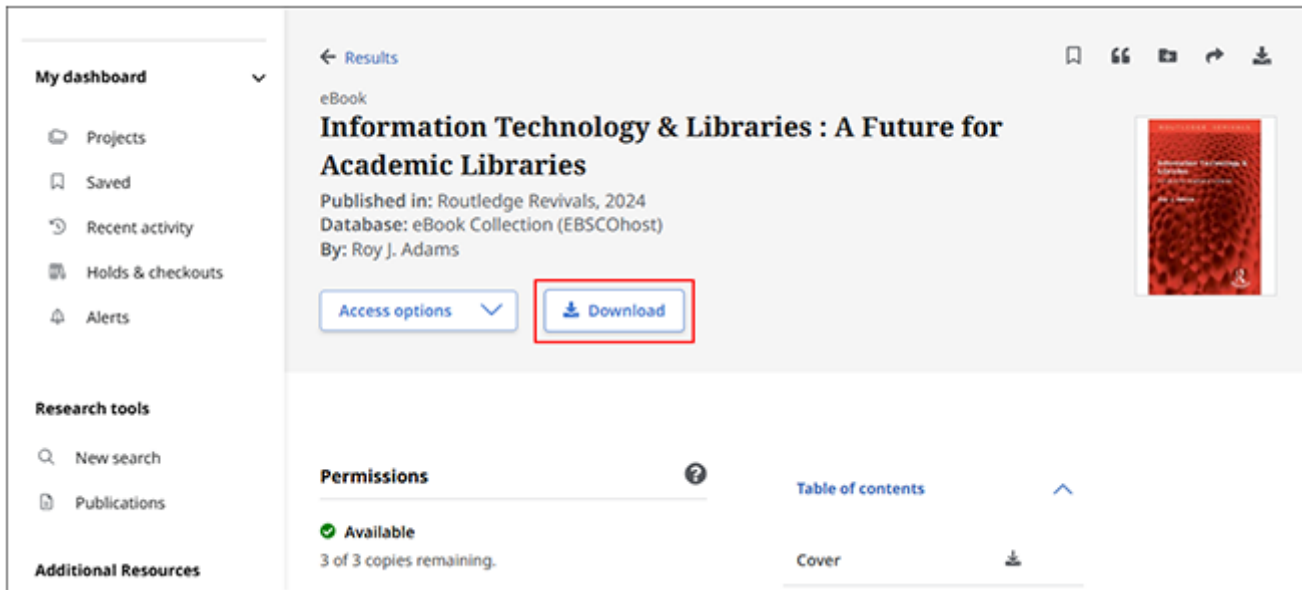
