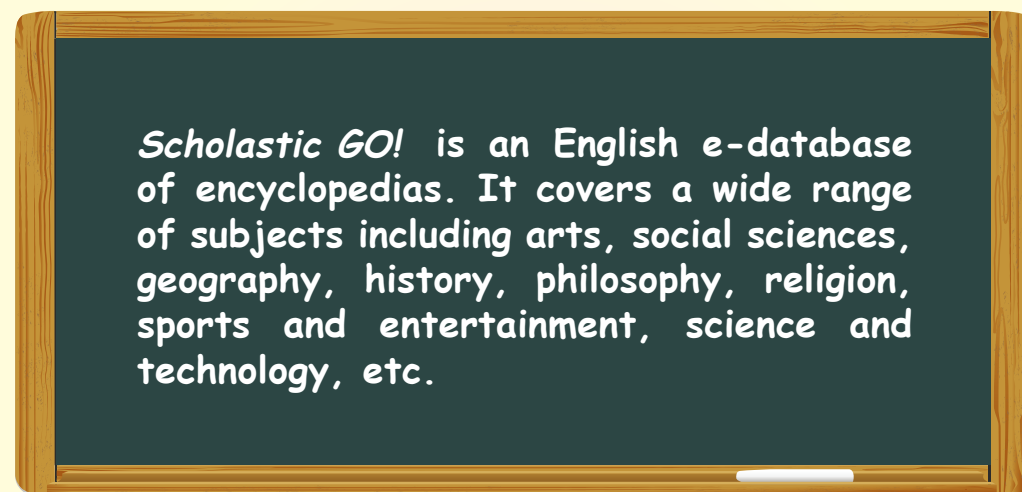
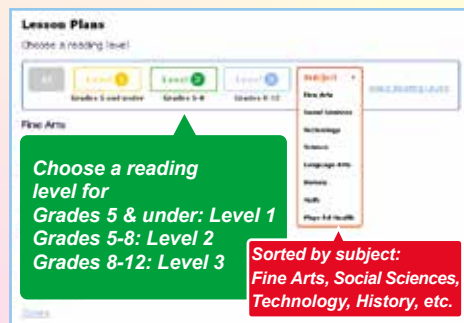

V. Other Features

1. Standards Alignment

Click the “Standards Alignment” link to gain access to a drop-down list of state and national standards with curriculum standards appropriate to the given article.

2. E-mail

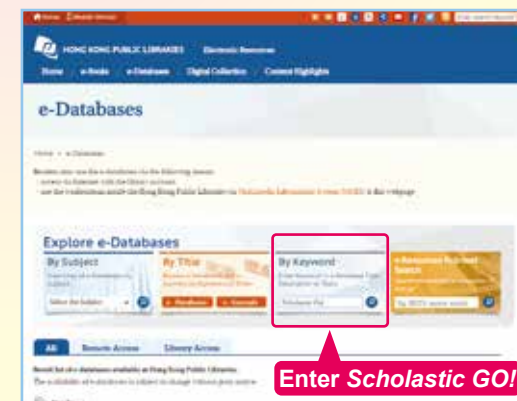
Click “E-mail” and fill in the e-mail address to which the article is to be sent.

Click “Turn Read Aloud On” and click the sentence to be read aloud. The text will be highlighted in yellow and the words being read out will appear in blue. To disable this function, click “Turn Read Aloud Off”.

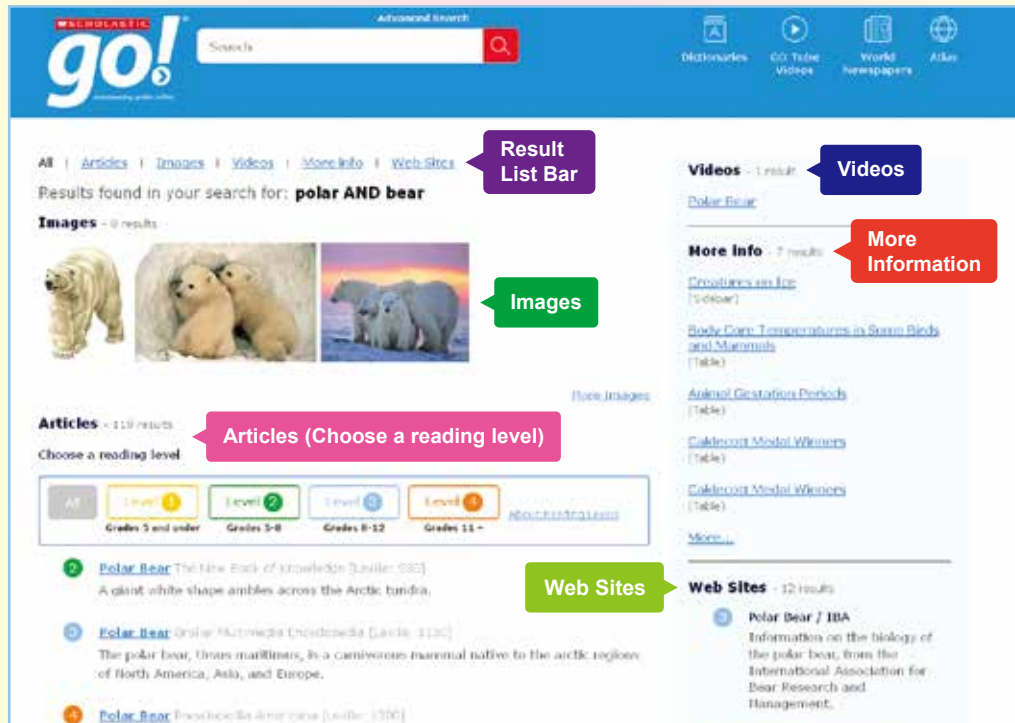

III. Special features



1. Dictionaries

You may check the definition and listen to the audio pronunciation of a word or phrase in the text you are reading. Click the “Dictionaries” icon and input the word or phrase. Alternatively, you may double-click the word or phrase and then click the “Dictionaries” icon. Click  to listen to the audio pronunciation.

2. GO Tube Videos

You may browse the entire GO Tube collection and watch the videos. Click the “GO Tube Videos” icon and  to play the videos.



3. World Newspapers

A searchable database of URL addresses for newspapers around the world is provided. Click the “World Newspapers” icon and select the drop-down menu of countries and international organizations.

4. Atlas

“Maps Search”, “Geopolitical”, “Thematic”, “Exploration” and “Global Distances” functions are provided. By clicking a desired place on the map, related articles and information will appear to facilitate further study.
