

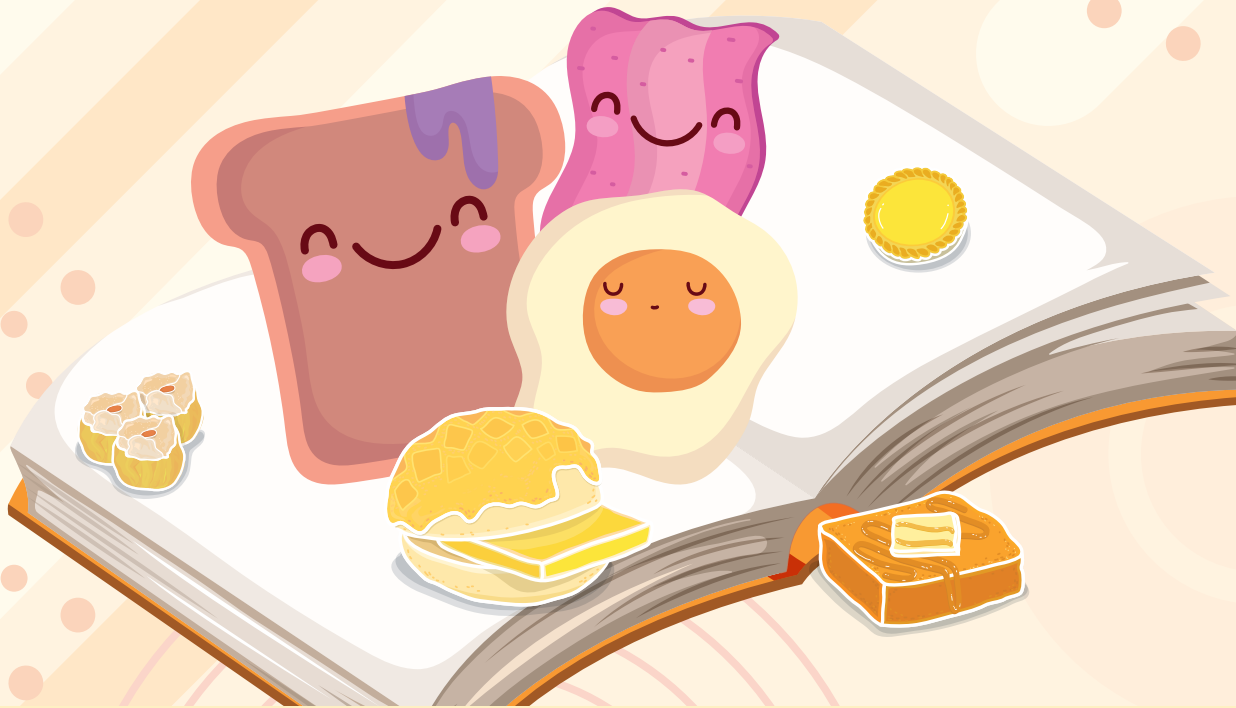

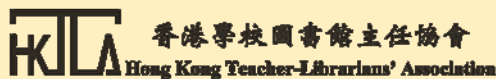

- (2) All entries have to be nominated by schools.
- (3) Each school may nominate up to 5 entries for each category.

- (7) 參賽者須確保其參賽作品為個人原創，從未參加同類比賽。如主辦機構有合理理由認為參賽者及其參賽作品涉及抄襲、侵犯版權、違反或抵觸在香港實施的任何法律、或可能構成危害國家安全罪行或不利於國家安全，可取消其參賽及得獎資格，參賽者亦須就其違規行為承擔法律責任。
- (8) 主辦機構無須承擔任何因參賽者違反「比賽條款及細則」而引致的法律責任，並有權取消任何違規參賽者的參賽資格。被取消資格的參賽者須向主辦機構退還任何獲頒的獎項及獎品。
- (9) 得獎者（同時為得獎作品的版權持有人）須同意授權政府使用其得獎作品的內容及評委就得獎作品提出的任何意見，包括但不限於以紙本及電子形式複製、編輯/剪輯、記錄、刊登、出版發售/贈閱、展覽、宣傳、推廣、演繹、廣播、傳播；以及貯存於政府管理或使用的任何媒體/系統/網絡以供公眾人士閱覽等用途。
- (10) 評審結果以評判委員及主辦機構的決定為準，參賽者不得對有關決定提出異議。
- (11) 主辦機構對評審工作安排有最終決定權，並且有權不頒發任何獎項及獎品，參賽者不得對有關決定提出異議。
- (12) 比賽詳情、條款及細則如有未盡之處，主辦機構有權加以詮釋和修訂，參賽學校及參賽者不得對有關決定提出異議。



## 比賽條款及細則

參賽者提交作品，即視作同意並接受下列條款及細則：

- (1) 參賽者必須填妥參賽表格上的所有資料，並且在「參賽者聲明及承諾」一欄簽署作實；未有簽署或未能提供足夠資料者可能會被取消參賽資格。
- (2) 參賽作品不得標示個人資料或學校名稱。
- (3) 除初小組外，其他組別的參賽作品須在參賽表格註明書籍或閱讀資料的詳情及出處：
  - 書籍—書名、作者、出版社名稱及出版年份
  - 報刊—報刊名稱、頁面編號及印發日期
  - 網頁—網頁名稱、網址及瀏覽日期
  - 非印刷品資料—出處及出版年份
- (4) 各組別的參賽作品必須使用規定的紙張，並註明字數及頁碼，詳情如下：
  - 初小組參賽作品須為A4尺寸（210毫米×297毫米），繪畫在單面白畫紙上。
  - 其他組別的參賽作品可用電腦打印（字體大小宜等於或不少於12）或以黑色原子筆書寫在400格的原稿紙（中文作品適用）或A4尺寸（210毫米×297毫米）的單行紙（英文作品適用）上。
  - 初中組參賽作品須同時提交食物或菜式成品的手繪圖畫或照片一幅。請以A4尺寸無任何花紋的白紙繪圖，或把照片張貼或彩色打印在白紙上。
  - 如參賽者提供的作品（初小組除外）是以電腦輸入，請保留原文檔，主辦機構可能會要求得獎者提供原文檔以作「比賽條款及細則」第（9）項訂明的用途。
- (5) 參賽作品一經提交，便不可修改，無論獲獎與否，概不發還。參賽者請自留底稿，主辦機構不會把稿件退還。

## Submission

- (1) Application forms can be obtained from all public libraries or downloaded from the HKPL webpage at [www.hkpl.gov.hk/wbd](http://www.hkpl.gov.hk/wbd). The form can be photocopied for use.
- (2) **Each entry** must be submitted together with a **duly completed application form** on or before the deadline in one of the following ways:

    - For submission by post, the postmark date will be regarded as the date of submission. Late submissions or underpaid mail items will not be accepted.or
  - (ii) **By email (not applicable to the Junior Primary Category)**

    - For submission by email, the original application forms bearing signatures of the students and school stamps (which will serve as official documents authorising the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (the Government) to use the entries concerned) should be subsequently submitted by post or in person.
    - Please specify **"4•23 World Book Day Creative Competition in 2023"** on the subject of the email.
    - Please state the **number of entries** for **each category** in the email.
    - All entries should be submitted in MS WORD or PDF format in A4 size (210 mm x 297 mm) with a font size preferably not smaller than 12.
    - For entries forwarded by email, the date on the forwarded email will be regarded as the date of submission. Any email sent or forwarded after the deadline will not be accepted.

## Rules and Regulations

Upon submission of their entries, participants will be regarded as agreeing to and accepting the following rules and regulations:

- (1) Participants must provide all the information required in the application form, and sign the "Participant's Declaration and Undertaking" for confirmation. Failure to sign or to provide sufficient information may lead to disqualification.
- (2) Participants' personal particulars and the names of their schools must not be shown on the entries.
- (3) Except for the Junior Primary Category, entries of other categories must be submitted with **details and sources of books or reading materials** provided on the application forms:
  - Books – title of the book, author(s), publisher and year of publication
  - Newspapers and periodicals – name of the newspaper/periodical, page number and date of issue
  - Website information – name of the website, URL and date of access
  - Non-print materials – source and year of publication
- (4) Entries of all categories must be presented on the kind of paper specified below, with word count and page numbers:
  - Entries of the Junior Primary Category must be drawn on one-sided A4-size (210 mm x 297 mm) white drawing paper.
  - Entries of other categories can be printed by computer printers (with a font size preferably not smaller than 12) or written with a **black ball pen** on 400-grid Chinese manuscript paper (for Chinese entries) or on A4-size (210 mm x 297 mm) single-lined paper (for English entries).
  - A hand-drawn picture or photo of the food/dish made should be submitted together with the entries of the Junior Secondary Category. The picture should be drawn on A4-size plain white paper, while the photo should either be affixed to or colour-printed on white paper.
  - Participants should retain the original files of their entries (except those of the Junior Primary Category) which are typeset by the use of a computer. Award winners may be required to provide the files for the purposes specified in Point (9) of the "Rules and Regulations" of Competition.
- (5) All entries, upon submission, cannot be amended and, whether awarded or not, will not be returned. Participants are advised to retain a copy of their entries, as all entries will not be returned.

- (6) Participants shall keep their entries confidential and adopt necessary measures to ensure that the contents of their entries will not be disclosed to any third party, and such entries will not be released or published in any form or through any channel (including but not limited to online channels). Participants who breach the rules and regulations will be disqualified.
- (7) Participants shall ensure that their entries are their original works which have not been submitted to any competition of the same kind. If the organiser has reasonable grounds to believe that participants and their entries may involve plagiarism, infringement of copyright, breach or contravention of any laws in force in Hong Kong, or may be contrary to the interests of national security, participants shall be disqualified and bear legal responsibility.
- (8) The organiser shall not be liable for any breach of the "Rules and Regulations" of Competition by the participants, and has the right to disqualify any participant who breaches the rules and regulations. Disqualified participants shall return any award and prize received to the organiser.
- (9) Award winners, as copyright owners of the winning entries, shall agree to authorise the Government to use the contents of the winning entries and any comments made by the adjudicators on the winning entries for purposes including but not limited to reproduction, editing/clipping, recording, publication, issuing for sale/free distribution, display, publicity, promotion, interpretation, broadcast and dissemination in paper or electronic format, as well as storage in any media/systems/networks managed or used by the Government for public access.
- (10) The decision of the adjudicators and the organiser on the adjudication results shall be final. Participants shall raise no objection.
- (11) The organiser has the right to make final decision on the adjudication arrangements and the right not to present any award or prize. Participants shall raise no objection.
- (12) The organiser has the right to further interpret or amend the Details and the Rules and Regulations of Competition. Participating schools and participants shall raise no objection.

## Announcement of Results

The results will be announced in April 2023. Respective schools of the award winners will be notified individually. All award winners and their schools will be invited to receive their awards at the award presentation ceremony to be held in April 2023. Winning entries will be displayed in roving exhibitions of public libraries from late April onwards.
