To further enhance the security of readers' online accounts, with effect from 4 March 2019, passwords for login to library online accounts must be at least 8 characters long and contain at least 1 uppercase letter, 1 lowercase letter and 1 digit. Otherwise, the system would request for immediate change of password upon login, and this must be completed before access to the account is allowed. Example of strong password: Abwin100 (Please do not use it as your password.)
