


By logging in to your HKPL registered account, you can check out audiobooks via the EBSCOhost site, and download and listen to them using the EBSCO Audiobooks app.



## 1. Search an Audiobook

*Step 1: Enter the search term(s) in the search box and click the “Search” button to view the search results, or look for what you want in “Browse by Category”.*

*Step 2: From the result list, click the audiobook title for more details.*

## 2. Borrow an Audiobook

Step 1: From the result list, click **“Borrow”** to check out the audiobook, or click **“Sample”** to listen to a sample.

Step 2: Sign in to your **My EBSCOhost** account.

## 3. Download an AudioBook (EBSCOhost Audiobook App is required)

Step 1: Log in with **My EBSCOhost ID**. You will see the audiobook title on the **“All Books”** tab.

Step 2: Click the **“Download”** button.

Step 3: Tap the **“Play”** button to listen to the audiobook.
