## Advanced Search

- Click on **Advanced Search** in the homepage or under **SEARCH OPTIONS**
- Allow entering keywords into multiple search boxes with a maximum of 10 rows
- Customize your search options such as **Subject, Person – About** and **ISSN**
- Filter your search results by ticking **Full Text Documents, Peer-Reviewed Journals, or Document Contains Images**
- Set specific publication dates for your search

**OVERVIEW**



Annie Jump Cannon

The American astronomer Annie Jump Cannon (1863-1941) made her most outstanding contribution to modern astronomy in the field of stellar spectral classification. Her legacy continued long after her death, as her accomplishments were featured on a 2104 episode of the TV series *Cosmos: A Spacetime Odyssey*. She was also honored in the 2010s by a Google Doodle and a one-dollar state coin design.

Annie Jump Cannon was born in Dover, Delaware, on December 11, 1863, the daughter of Wilson Lee Cannon and Mary Elizabeth Jump Cannon. One of the first Delaware women to enroll in college, she attended Wellesley College (class of 1884). Back at Wellesley in 1894 after a decade at home, she did graduate studies in mathematics, physics,...

OVERVIEW

Mae Jemison received two undergraduate degrees and a medical degree, served two years as a Peace Corps medical officer in West Africa, and was selected to join the National Aeronautics and Space Administration's (NASA) astronaut training program before her thirtieth birthday. Her eight-day space flight aboard the space shuttle Endeavour in 1992 established Jemison as the United States' first female African American space traveler.

Mae Carol Jemison was born on October 17, 1956, in Decatur, Alabama, the youngest child of Charlie Jemison, a roofer and carpenter, and Dorothy Green Jemison, an elementary school teacher. Her sister, Ada Jemison Bullock, became a child psychiatrist, and her brother, Charles Jemison, became a real estate broker. The family moved to Chicago, Illinois, when...

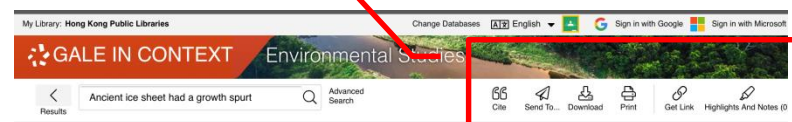
